 Telegraphing The painted finishes are applied to solid wood and veneer surfaces. Oak is an open or coarse grain wood. The grain will "telegraph" or show visibly throughout the finish. Maple is a close or fine gain wood. Some "telegraphing" will occur, though the effect will be subtle. Joint Fracture Because wood is a product that is in a constant state of expansion and contraction, hairline fractures will very soon be noticeable at the joints on the door and drawer fronts. These hairline cracks will not weaken the finish, but they will be visible. As purchaser of this product, we want you to be fully informed of the following characteristics; therefore it is important that you find them acceptable 	Some trees vary in color from shades of white, pink, green, gray, and black. Some have even grain patterns; others can be quite wild. Some have worm tracks and pitch marks and mineral streaks. Some absorb stain readily; others practically refuse to absorb. Some tend to get darker and some considerably darker (especially Cherry) as time passes. Columbia Cabinets Ltd. uses only the finest kiln dried hardwoods available. Because no two pieces of wood are exactly the same, there may be slight variations in color. The differences in the grain and patterns add to the natural beauty the solid woods and veneers give. All hardwoods may contain some pin knots, which add to the natural beauty of the wood. Cherry and maple occasionally have mineral streaks that could be darker when stained. Rift White Oak has a grain pattern that is narrow and straight with minimal flake.	Columbia Cabinets Ltd. offers handcrafted finishes often referred to as artistic finishes. These artistic finishes (up to 14 steps) include the cottage finishes, glazing, distressing and rub through. These artistic finishes are unique to each color, for example Café Caramel includes directional hand brushing with fine brush lines of glaze while Cashmere has a bottled-in dark glaze hang up which remains in the corners and crevices. Just as the uniqueness of an artist's painting, so it will be with your kitchen finish. Although Columbia Cabinets will try to reproduce the finish as close to the sample as possible, you should expect variations in the amount of hang-up, the intensity of the brush stroking, and some variations in color tone. Although standards and specific procedures are followed in the distressing and rub through processes, one needs to remember that these are hand crafted finishes, and some variations will appear, and are considered acceptable.
